NNAMS Checklist – Key Information Required

This short checklist sets out the key information we will need to prepare a Nutrient Neutrality Assessment (NNAMS) for your site. Every NNAMS is unique, but having this information ready helps avoid delays and ensures we can apply our NNAMS Navigator™ process efficiently.

- 1 Site location and red-line boundary plan**
- 2 Site address and post code**
- 3 Proposed development layout, including the number and type of dwellings/units**
- 4 Current land use and site conditions (e.g. agricultural type, brownfield, greenfield)**
- 5 Foul drainage strategy (connection to mains sewer, treatment plant, or alternative)**
- 6 Surface water drainage strategy (including SuDS proposals, where applicable)**
- 7 Any known constraints or previous assessments related to nutrient neutrality**
- 8 Timescales or planning deadlines for your application**

Having this information ready allows us to move quickly through the five stages of the NNAMS Navigator™ and provide a clear, defensible assessment tailored to your site.
